Riverside Rovers FC – Players Regulations

1. Fees;

- Membership/Registration £10.00 per player to be paid by date given by manager.
- Training/Match fees £5.00 per week for the playing season and £2 per week for closed season.
- Any player who's sub's are owed for a period longer than 4 weeks will have their right to play in all match's removed until sub's are up to date.
- The team manager will charge entry to Tournaments appropriately.
- Personal accident insurance is included in registration fee.
- Players transferring to the club must pay the league fee plus the club membership/registration fee. Players registering after 1st January will be required to pay the league fee and £5.00 club membership/registration fee.

2. Attendance;

- If a player is unable to attend a match/training the team manager is to be notified ASAP.
- All Players are expected to attend training sessions; failure to do so, is taken into consideration when team selections are made for the next match.

3. Kit;

- The player must maintain any kit provided by the club for match day wear.
- If leaving the club, all kit issued to be returned to club.
- Players to take to the field of play, smart and shirts tucked into shorts.
- **Shin pads must be worn for training and for Matches.**

4. Behaviour;

- A players behaviour on or off the pitch should always be a credit to the club. He/She should show respect to Referees and club officials.
- A player who is sent off or booked will pay his/hers fine to the FA via the club secretary, unless found innocent at a subsequent hearing. A player may also be disciplined or fined by the club, if they bring the club into disrepute by actions both verbal or physical whilst representing the club.

- A player damaging property wilfully or by disregard of club rules, maybe suspended for a period decided by the management committee and may also be fined a minimum of £25.00.
 - Complaints or allegations of misconduct against an officer/official together with any other evidence must be put in writing and forwarded to the club secretary without delay under signature. A minimum of 48hrs notice prior to the disciplinary meeting shall be given to the alleged. The notice will contain the relevant allegations/charges. The alleged shall have the right to be supported by a witness if desired. The disciplinary committee will be 4 officers from the club and the club secretary.

5. Club Property;

- If a player leaves the club all property inc kit must be returned immediately.
- Any Player causing any damage to the club or opposition clubs property must pay in full the cost of the damage.

6. Team Officials;

- The people that run the club do so voluntarily and spend much time, energy and money on you. All club officials are FA checked against the protection of children act and support the FA's child protection policy. Please help them by keeping to our rules and showing your appreciation to them as and when the opportunity arises.

7. Child Protection Policy;

- The club has adopted the FA child protection policy. If any person is found verbally or physically abusing any child at any training sessions or matches, the club would have no hesitation in reporting the incident to the FA child protection officer. This policy includes young referees.

8. Qualities of a Riverside Rovers FC player;

- A good winner and a good loser.
- Accepts all decisions in the proper spirit.
- Applauds good play on both sides.
- Never use's foul or abusive language, never use racial/sexist remarks.
